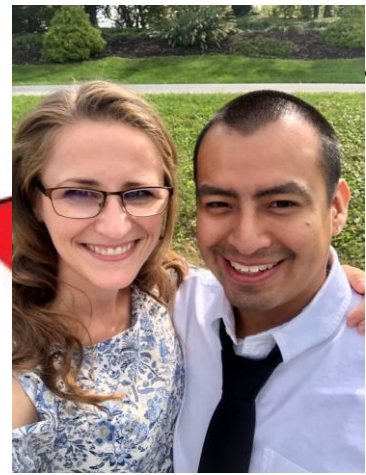


Meet the teacher... Miss Wilhelm
